

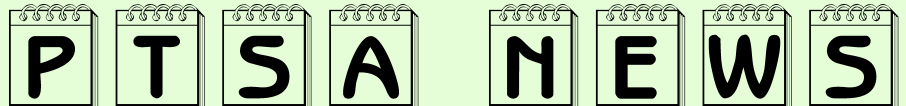

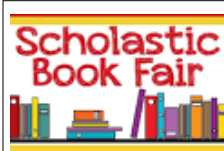

The West Valley School District has adopted a program called Imagine Learning district wide.

This program requires the use of headphones with an attached microphone.
