






Message from our Principal— Mrs. Siguenza



Put your creativity to work!


Design a picture that represents Cottonwood Elementary and you may see your creation published on the FRONT OR BACK COVER of our yearbook!


Take your time and do your BEST work! Be creative. You have all of winter break, don't rush.

Drawing must be 8 ½ x 11 inches **VERTICAL**, not horizontal.





- Drawing must be original, **NO TRACING**.
- The more color, the better! <u>Darker drawings show up better</u>.

 (pencil drawings don't show up for copying purposes)
 - Drawing must represent Cottonwood Elementary.
 - Words must be spelled **CORRECTLY.**

(Parents: please help with this, misspelled words will disqualify the drawing. This is very important.)

ON THE BACK OF THE DRAWING, IN PENCIL, please include:

- 1. First and Last Name—do not write name on the front.
- 2. Teacher's name / Grade

First Place – Front Cover Second Place – Back Cover (Additional entries could be included inside the yearbook—space permitting)
