- * Attend conferences, parent meetings, and school events. Research shows that parent involvement is tied to higher grades and test scores.

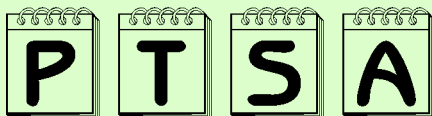

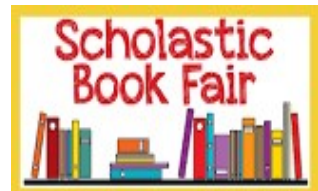
